Sue Palmer is a writer, speaker and broadcaster on the subject of child development and education in the modern world. After 15 years as a nationally respected authority on literacy teaching, in 2006 she published *Toxic Childhood* which helped spark a national debate on the nature of contemporary childhood. She has been described in *The Scotsman* as one of the country's ‘new radical thinkers’.

In her latest book, *21st Century Boys*, she looks at the particular problems confronting the parents of boys, from birth to the teenage years. This talk draws on her research for this book and how best we can bring up boys to be bright, balanced young men, ready for the challenges of the 21st century.

His first book, *In Praise of Slow*, examines our compulsion to hurry and chronicles a global trend toward putting on the brakes. His second book, *Under Pressure*, explores the good, the bad and the ugly of modern childrearing - and offers a blueprint for change. His books have been translated into more than 30 languages and landed on bestseller lists in many countries.
