



Early Years Free Entitlement Admissions Policy

Brighton Steiner School | EYFE Standalone Admissions (abridged) Policy

Early Years Admissions relating to the 15 Hours and 30 Hours Standalone Early Years Free Entitlement (EYFE) are allocated based on the following criteria. Places for EYFE Standalone Place are limited to availability and subject to application 8 weeks in advance of the term in which the applicant is enrolling into.

EYFE Standalone Admissions Criteria

- A pupil/child that is a Looked After Child in the care of the Local Authority
- A pupil/child that is in receipt of an Educational Health Care Plan (EHCP)
- A pupil/child with an assessed Special Education Need or Disability
- A pupil/child in attendance to an Early Years Setting
- A pupil/child of staff coming to or already working in the school
- An applicant to an Early Years Setting
- To the siblings of existing pupils attending the school
- To the children of past pupils of Brighton Steiner School
- To children from other Steiner schools
- To those families who have demonstrated their commitment to Steiner Education on a first come first served basis

EYFE Standalone Admissions Procedure

1. Complete and submit an Early Years Application 8 weeks in advance of the term of enrolment
2. Complete and submit an EYFE Standalone Admissions Slip 8 weeks in advance of the term of enrolment
3. Ensure that the E-Voucher number is made available to the School at the point of application
