#### **TERRIFIED KATHMANDU**

Although the people were experiencing aftershocks of smaller magnitudes, almost all have begun or getting ready to come back to normalcy. In fact, the people started to give it a damn care to the aftershocks of smaller magnitudes. We all believed in what the experts had to say. Their unanimous version was that Nepal probably would not be hit by another bigger earthquake than the previous one (7.6 Richter scale) as this has been trend so far in the history of earthquake and the nature has started to settle down. It is obvious to feel such small tremors in the settling down process of the earth.

Based on the versions of the experts, we at Tashi Waldorf School also had started to counsel the parents and children whom we could contact informing them to normalize their daily lives. We were also ready to reopen our school on the 14<sup>th</sup> May 2015 as per the government's direction. But proving the experts and us wrong, a very powerful earthquake hit Nepal once again. Following the second massive earth quake of Tuesday the Education Ministry has also decided to suspend the opening of all the educational Institutions until 1<sup>st</sup> of June. Thus we also will reopen our school for new academic session if everything goes fine from the above date.

After the 17 days of devastating earthquake that virtually destroyed Nepal, when the people were gradually starting to return back to their normal life, we experienced yet another massive aftershock (we felt it as an earthquake) of 6.8 Richter scale magnitude (but according to an American agency UGSS it was 7.3 Richter scale) on the 18<sup>th</sup> day at about 1 O'clock in the afternoon. This aftershock did the rest of destruction left over by the first earthquake of the 25<sup>th</sup> April. All the houses that had developed cracks during the first quake have been collapsed and many new buildings have developed severe cracks. Landslides have come in many places sweeping out the entire village. Evacuation works done by the government were not sufficient. The geological structures of most of the hilly villages have been weakened by the earthquake. In one month's time monsoon will start which apprehensively will sweep those villages. Apart from these, avalanches have occurred in Mountainous villages killing many Nepalis and a few foreign nationals also.

The total death toll due to the first earth quake is almost nine thousand and injured number is around nineteen thousand and the second hit caused death of ninety one person already and and injured is more than two thousand so far. According to local media the death toll is going to escalate in the near future.

We feel that the Nature God had been very angry and upset with Nepal and the Nepalis this time. That is why such devastating incidents are taking place in Nepal one after another. We just pray and request you to pray for us to end such catastrophe as soon as possible. What is the most terrifying things for us is that the epicenter of the smaller tremors has been coming closer to Kathmandu. We feel even a tremor of 4 Richter scale magnitude will be enough to destroy the ancient city of Kathmandu.

The people of Nepal in earthquake affected districts and specially in Kathmandu valley are very much terrified. No one feels safe enough to be alive. The recent trend of the earthquake has caused more terror in the minds of the people. Even a small noise that comes from moving a table, closing window or shutting door is sufficient to cause terror in our minds. I am terrified (from within myself) even my colleague coughs or sneezes loudly let alone other people. If you talk of the recent earthquakes to anyone, all have the same voice that they do not have any idea how long they will be alive. This kind of feeling of insecurity has prevailed in the minds of all of us. No one believes to be alive any longer. We all feel shattered.

Those who have started to come to sleep at their houses have once again went to sleep under makeshift shelters like temporary tents and many spent their nights under the open sky. One can imagine how cruel the nature has been when we had heavy rain with thunderstorms scaring people almost to death.

The number of people leaving Kathmandu for their home town is also on the rise day by day, thinking of living together and dieing together with their own family members and beloved ones. In fact it has crossed more than 1.3 million.

On the other hand, relief materials and money are being poured in Nepal from international community but due to the poor management of the government the deserving and the neediest people were not able to get the relief materials whereas some people having access got the same more than once – we have read this in the news.

#### **REQUEST TO OUR WELLWISHERS:**

It has been noticed in Kathmandu that all money sent by generous people/organization around the world to help Nepal will go direct to **THE PRIME MINISTER'S NATURAL CALAMITY FUND** if the earthquake is mentioned anywhere while sending the money. If your donations go to that fund we will never know how and when the fund will be utilized.
