Dear Parents

Our next open day is coming up on Saturday 16th May from 11am to 2pm and yes open days are for you too. It is a chance to see areas of the school you may be unfamiliar with, such as to look at the next stage of your child's educational journey.

Come along and hear more about the lower and middle school curricula. Find out about the range of GCSEs currently available including sciences, see the science lab and speak with Rachel, one of our science teachers. Pupils' work will be on display, including a woodwork session. Meet and talk with subject, class and upper school teachers.
